
## 2017 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Expansion of Pre-employment transition services (Pre-ets) to students with disabilities
- Provision of Career Counseling and Information (CCIR) Services to individuals employed in or seeking sub-minimum wage employment
- Enhanced partnership with Department of Workforce Development
- Enhanced data collection and federal reporting requirements
